Other Descriptive Information

This collection includes a number of plays apparently written by Madame Anne Louise Boyvin d'Hardancourt Brillon de Juoy, a prominent Parisian salon hostess and musician. The authorship of some of the plays is not entirely clear.

A second, related collection, <u>Musical Compositions, 18th Century (Mss.781.508.B762)</u>, contains a number of musical compositions by Brillon. Her most famous composition, Le Marche des Insurgents, which was inspired by the American victory at Saratoga, is included in this collection. Many of these compositions are handwritten and appear to be from the eighteenth century, although it is unclear when they were written and who wrote them.

Combined, the two collections capture the creative work of one of the most prominent French women of the time.
